Breadalbane Community Larder

As you may know, Breadalbane Community Larder has been Aberfeldy Co-op's 'FoodShare' partner since March, 2020 taking 'Best Before' and 'Use By' food which would otherwise be thrown away or sent to their bio-digester. Not wanting to lose this valuable partnership, we will continue to collect these items and have this food available outside the rear of the church building for people to come and help themselves during Larder opening times (**11.00am -12.30pm each Saturday**).

We are also be piloting two other ideas:

- alongside the 'FoodShare store' on a Saturday morning, customers can come to the Larder and collect items from the stock indoors, for a nominal fee. This reduces the stigma and helps maintain customer dignity
- emergency deliveries of food parcels will continue. This service can be accessed by calling **0345 30 111 00 Monday to Friday 9.00am - 5.00pm**

If you know of anyone struggling to make ends meet please let them know about the support provided by Breadalbane Community Larder.

Coop Member Pioneer – Stuart Brain

I have taken on the Member Pioneer role with the Coop and would like to introduce what my role is. The role is as a communicator between the local community, cause, charities and the Coop itself and also to find ways to encourage the causes to "self-promote" on the various Coop web resources and Facebook and in normal conditions have from time to time a presence in store. The role is also to find new causes that may want to receive funding via the community fund.

I can direct you to the community fund where you can make an application for a small lump sum £250 - you have to be listed on the website to apply. Obviously certain criteria must be met to make sure causes are legitimate!

Applications re-opened in February, if you are considering an event, I would look to give us as much notice as possible if you want to apply for the community fund, applications take a wee while!

I have set up a Facebook page @highlandperthshirememberpioneer that can be used to promote the three current causes as well as list updates from past organisations that have received funding and is also used for highlighting events and other such like information.

It would be worth investigating this, it would be for a particular project, say if you were replacing equipment or the like. The Co-operate website will get causes started on that path.
